Performance Trend Analysis

Vocabulary Progress (+52.5 Point Growth)

Vocabulary represents L. Pinilla's highest area of relative growth. Starting from an initial baseline of 28.0% in January 2024, scores steadily expanded through 2024 before surging to 80.0% in April 2025 and reaching a sustained peak of 80.5% by April 2026.

Writing Mastery (Strong Peak Achievement)

Writing skills demonstrated substantial progress from a baseline of 56.0% in October 2023. After escalating to a peak level of 92.0% in April 2025, writing performance stabilized at a strong proficiency tier of 83.0% in April 2026.

English Grade Trajectory

Overall English Grade coursework shifted upward over time, transitioning from early scores in the 59.0%–66.0% range up to a high of 78.0% in April 2026, indicating consistent integration of core language arts competencies.

Academic Recommendations & Action Items

- Targeted Vocabulary Acquisition:** Reinforce higher-tier vocabulary retention strategies to solidify performance above the 80% threshold consistently across all terms.
- Sustain Writing Excellence:** Capitalize on strong writing composition abilities (peaking at 92.0%) by introducing advanced persuasive essays and structured literary analysis.
- English Grade Maintenance:** Continue structured study schedules to maintain overall English course marks at or above the 78% target moving forward.
